August Minutes: reviewed and accepted

Treasurer's Report: Madeline noted that there were checks missing from the check book. It was discovered that they had been skipped and subsequently destroyed. Check 1002 was issued in the amount of \$31.49. At present, it's an unknown expense. We believe it may be the set-up and printing fee for business cards. 2016 budget request is to be submitted to area by October. Minutes accepted and approved.

Old Business:

- F. Schools:** May get some input following Area Committee meeting. Cheryl P. suggested we look into the logistics as to how to check schools. Crafting a script so the message is the same for all schools was also suggested. In addition, checking to see if library catalogues may be on line or if their might be a Board of Education contact

might be available.

G. PSA: Madeline will check with the Messenger regarding a PSA. One of the groups asked if there was a charge for the announcement and if so, who pays. We assured the contact that there wasn't.
