Treasurer's Report: approved, Madeline stated that room rental has been paid through the end of the year. For the sake of the new attendee, discussion of access to account, signers, and not having debit card tied to the account.

Old Business:

- a) Progress on accurate website information/action: Nita posted in the tip of the month the sites that contain accurate information on AA. Three Legacies is placing the list on all of their literature. A suggestion that group CPC/PI reps announce these websites at meetings they attend. The committee proposed and is investigating meeting schedules from COGF having all websites printed on the cover-awaiting response.

- c) Area Inventory Question-Feedback? Question: Reflecting on the guidelines, is Area53 achieving its goals? Comments from groups to be made at the September Assembly.
- d) Business Cards: Joy D. is the new coordinator and has ordered 1,000 more cards. Discussed how to better get and stay in touch with volunteers placing cards in libraries and other locations to maintain continuity. In addition, how do we get the word out to people that we need volunteers to monitor and maintain a supply of cards at these places? She would also like to have a list of zip codes of volunteers to better track the areas they might cover.
- e) Addiction Studies Institute (ASI) contact requests: Angela has emailed everyone on the list and to date has received no responses.
We did receive a letter from GSO, thanking us for participation in, and feedback about ASI.

New Business:
