Communications Committee

This committee manages the technical and digital presence of Area 53. It is divided into three main areas of focus:

- **Website Content:** Publishing news, events, and meeting minutes submitted by members.
- **Hosting & Security:** Maintaining the website platform, domain, and ensuring the site runs smoothly.
- **Audio/Visual:** Managing video conferencing (like Zoom) and supporting hybrid meetings to ensure members can participate both in person and online.

CPC / PI (Cooperation with the Professional Community / Public Information)

These two committees often work together with the goal of carrying the A.A. message to the "still-suffering alcoholic" by informing the public and professionals:

- **Public Information (PI):** Focuses on the general public and media. They provide accurate information to schools, businesses, and news outlets to clear up misconceptions about A.A.
- **Cooperation with the Professional Community (CPC):** Focuses on professionals who come into contact with alcoholics through their work, such as doctors, clergy, lawyers, and social workers. They provide information on what A.A. is and how it can be a resource for their clients or patients.

Accessibilities Committee

The mission of this committee is to ensure that the A.A. program and its resources are available to everyone, regardless of physical or mental barriers. They explore and offer "reasonable accommodations" for alcoholics with diverse needs, including:

- Those who are blind, deaf, or hard of hearing.
- Members who are homebound, in nursing homes, or have limited transportation.
- Individuals with language barriers or those who have difficulty using technology for virtual meetings.
