

# How2Vote by Web Browser

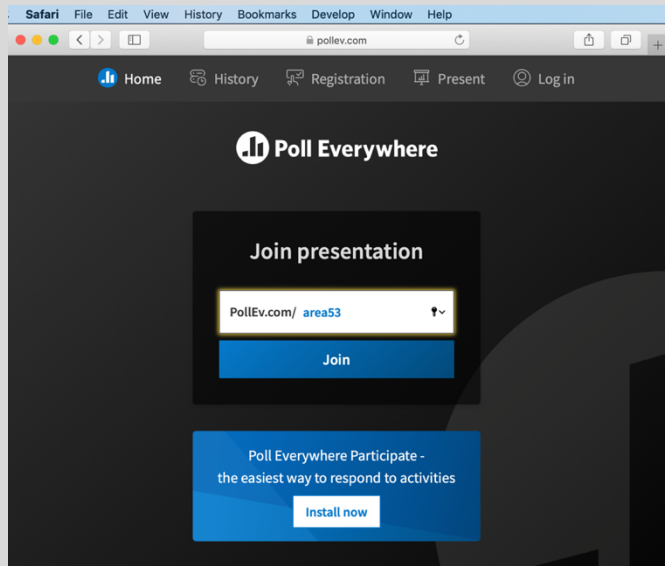
Area 53 is using **Poll Everywhere** ([www.polleverywhere.com](http://www.polleverywhere.com)) for voting at the Election Assembly. These instructions are for voting using a web browser. Pictures are from Safari and Firefox on a Macintosh. To participate, you must join the Area 53 Election Assembly Zoom Meeting.

Instructions	What it might look like in your browser

Open your web browser. Common browsers are Chrome, Firefox and Safari.

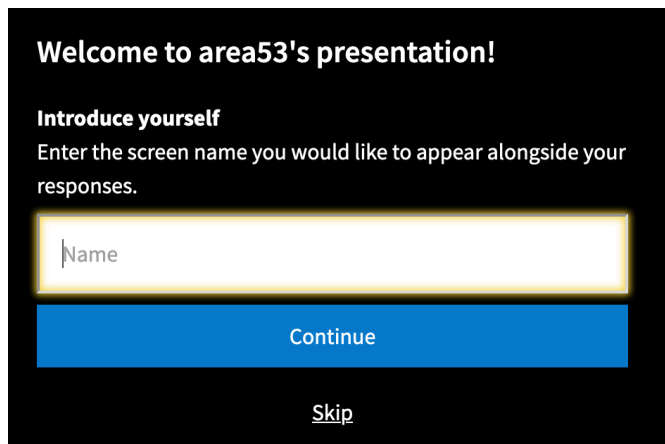
1. Go to: pollev.com
2. Enter **area53**
3. Click **Join**

It is not required that you click on **Install now**. The Poll Everywhere app is not required to participate in the election. **Do not click Install now.**



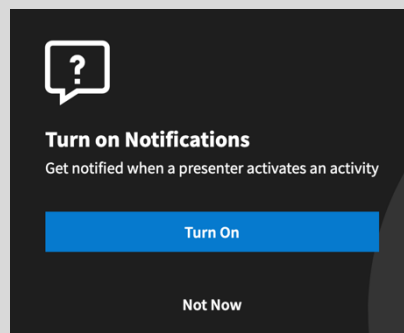
Name should be blank. Click on Skip.

**All voting will be anonymous.** Do not enter a screen name. **Nothing will appear alongside your responses.**



If this screen appears, click **Not Now**

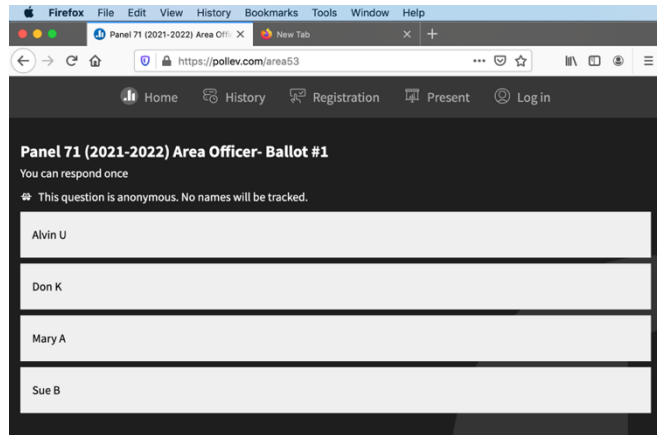

If voting has started, a ballot will appear. It may look similar to this image.

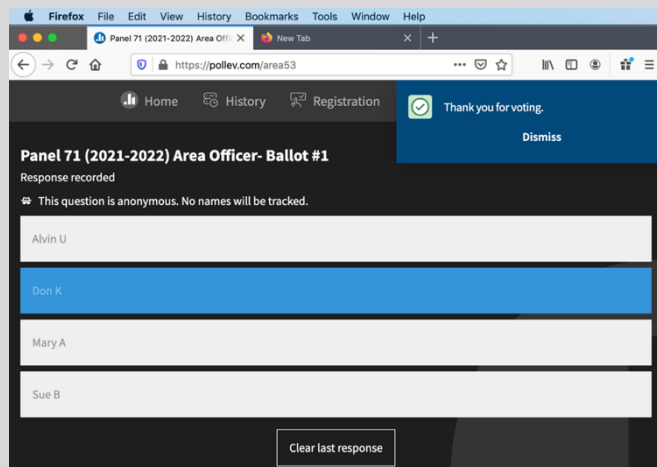
**“This question is anonymous. No names will be tracked.” This means that no voter names are recorded for the area election.**

Click on a name to record **your anonymous vote.**



Your vote will be highlighted as shown in this image. When the **Thank you** pop up will appears, click on **Dismiss**.

If you want to change your vote, click on **Clear last response** at the bottom.



**The current ballot of candidates will be displayed in the Area 53 Zoom meeting.** Listen for the instructions from the election chairperson.

Your browser will automatically refresh when a new ballot opens.
