- Technical support Zoom meeting hosts or co-hosts or behind the scenes support (as needed) at District or Area events.
- Project Researcher collect and summarize other Area group services programs or ideas. Stephen will develop a checklist and begin recruiting volunteers.

Mini-Conference GSR School & DCM Workshop – Martha C.

- Attendance DCM Workshop = 25, GSR School = 38. Generally positive response. The GSR School was viewed as informative. A good recap and the participants seemed engaged. One suggestion – the breakout rooms were too small and report outs from each would have been useful.
- We discussed ways to get feedback from the participants. Stephen will email the Mini-Conference Committee to see if they are planning an evaluation survey and whether we can piggyback it. Martha will provide questions if they are.
- We decided, for technical and privacy reasons, to not sent a request for feedback directly to the mini-Conference registrants. Stephen will email the DCMs to ask that informal feedback be sent to Martha. He will also ask for feedback at the April DCM Meeting.

GSR Orientation Project

- We kicked off this project at March Committee meeting. Lori R. will serve as the subcommittee co-chair.
- The Goal is a structured, formal Orientation program for new GSRs. Initial thinking is that it might be a three-month process, repeated each quarter.
- The first stage will be a mid-April GSR/DCM sharing session is to establish the content and process goals for the program. Stage 2 will produce and test the presentation material.
- We hope to introduce the program at the June 2021 Area Assembly. *This may be unrealistically ambitious.*
