

Area 53 Group Services Committee September Area Assembly Report

The Group Services Committee met in July and August to continue work on upgrading the Area's G.S.R. support program. Progress is limited by the small number of volunteers available. The hope is to have at least two modules posted before the end of the year and the full complement of modules completed during Panel 71.

Overview of the program.

A series of self-paced learning modules. Each stand-alone module can be self-administered or provide the content for an in-person or on-line GSR workshop. Each will include a formal presentation of the core material, a panel of GSRs sharing their experience with the material, and participant reflection questions.

Modules for the new GSR. Preliminary. 1. Getting Started. Role and expectations of a GSR. 2. Getting Registered. A step-by-step tutorial on how to register new groups and G.S.R.s. 3. Understanding the Area Service Structure. 4. Attending Your First Assembly.
