REGISTRAR'S REPORT TO AREA 53 ASSEMBLY SEPTEMBER 10, 2023

Groups in Area 53 – Currently there are 867 registered groups in Area 53. These include 699 Active groups with a contact and 2 Pending Active,. There are 166 Unknown groups with no contact.

166 Unknown Groups – General Service Office is requesting a more vigorous effort throughout the fellowship o investigate the status of Unknown Groups. These are groups for which there is no GSR or Mail Contact. Since GSO is no longer sending postal mail, the mailing address must be an email. Some of these 166 groups have probably closed. I will need help from the DCMs in determining which groups in their districts have closed?

GSO No Longer Sending Print Docs via Postal Mail

Our General Service Office has implemented a major policy decision to save money by no longer sending print documents via postal mail in favor of electronic documents via email. This change was implemented without consulting the General Service Conference. I do not believe this best serves the needs of the fellowship. Can GSRs and DCMs effectively share information when many do not have the resources to print the documents and take them to their groups or business meetings?

This assembly will consider the question of submitting a Proposed Agenda Item for the 74th General Service Conference that would give trusted servants an opportunity to choose whether they prefer correspondence in print via postal mail?
